

THE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To study, cultivate and demonstrate the art of music, drama, theatre, jatra, dancing, drawing, dance-drama, film, recreation, mime etc for public education.
2. To support and promote cultural activities through the universally appreciated medium of folk-art, music, theatre, film, painting and literature.
3. To preserve, propagate and perpetuate the performing arts, music, dance and drama.
4. To organize seminars and festivals national and international for the understanding and dissemination of Indian Music in India and abroad.
5. To promote and encourage advancement of international understanding, literature, cultural education and goodwill and peace through the spirit of co-operation.
6. To promote unity, harmony and self-discipline among the members as well as the local people through the bonds of friendship.
7. To open, establish training centres, research centres etc for music, drama, dance, mime, theatre, dance-drama, recitation, drawing and design, painting, handicrafts and also documentation of different streams, and to maintain and improve them.
8. To acquire, establish, start, aid, run, maintain or manage children's schools, park, play-ground, libraries, museum and art gallery.
9. To arrange and organize lectures, debates, discussion, seminars and excursions for the diffusion of knowledge.
10. To publish useful literatures, papers, magazines, books etc and to distribute them.
11. To help the needy students of all communities for the prosecution of studies.
12. To collect and preserve manuscripts, painting, sculptures, works of art, antiques, natural history, specimens, mechanical and scientific instruments and designs for documentation.
13. To help the aged, sick and helpless persons in different ways.
14. To help the local people in their physical activities through sports, games, travelling, trekking, climbing, swimming, boating etc.
15. To collect donation and subscriptions for the purpose of helping the Society.
16. To promote handicrafts, cottage and home industries.
17. To establish and maintain basic and adult education centre, nursery school.
18. To encourage the use of Scientific and Technological advancement while conserving the balance of the natural environment for the good of the people.

19. To accept any bequest gift, donation etc for rising fund of the Society.
20. To open and maintain charitable dispensaries, maternity home, children clinic, orphanage, family planning centre, short stay home, day care centre, destitute home etc.
21. To render relief to the suffering in time of famine, flood, drought, earthquake and other natural calamities.
22. To preserve folk and tribal art and culture and to promote them.
23. To promote national and foreign art through cultural exchange, exhibition, competition, conference, and workshop etc.
24. To write the history, collect specimens; make research on arts which are lying in the remote areas of the country.
25. To spread the art in all sphere of the life, to raise the standard of living and taste and mass education through audio visual medium.
26. To introduce training courses for Photography, Video Photography, Computer, Painting and Printing, Feature Films, Handicrafts, Mime, Dance, Musical Instruments, Songs and Music, Languages, English medium school and to produce documentary evidences.
27. To organize fairs etc for promotion and revitalization of the decaying culture of the tribal life.
28. Opening Art Academy and Teaching in the field of Art.
29. To collect fund or receive loan or grant-in-aid or gifts or donation of all kinds, monetary or otherwise such as movable or immovable properties from the Public in General, different Governments, Government Agencies or Undertakings or Non-Government Organization in India or Abroad for the interest of the Society.
30. To implement and supervise development program for the upliftment of rural economy.
31. To arrange functions, exhibitions, fairs, mela etc for the progress of arts, literature, science, culture, handicrafts etc in the Rural, Semi-Urban, Urban areas.
32. To provide necessary training in handicrafts mainly to the ladies, women and to help them in their way to self employment.
33. To organize training and similar activities for the upliftment of Rural.
34. To co-operate with the Government or Non-Government Organization for any development activity for the area.
35. To help, grow co-operation with individual or associations or clubs or any other organization to establish and to maintain any or all the objects of this association.

36. To develop Handicrafts such as knitting, tailoring etc for the economic development and up gradation of the un-employed youth. Handicapped and orphans are being helped by the organisation for their overall development and upliftment.
37. To engage and assist in such other Philanthropic activities as may be deemed appropriate by the Governing Body of the Society.
38. To do all such other things as are incidental and conducive to the attainments of the above objects or any one of them.

The activities shall be restricted within the scope of section 4(2) of the S.B.S.R. Act, 1961 and without profit motive also.
